Hung King Temple Festival

The Hung King Temple Festival, also known as the Hung King's Death Anniversary, is one of the most significant and revered festivals in Vietnam. It is held annually on the tenth day of the third lunar month to honor the legendary Hung Kings, who are considered the ancient ancestors and founders of the Vietnamese nation.

According to legend, thousands of years ago, Lac Long Quan (King Dragon of the Land of Lac) possessed superhuman strength and preferred to stay near water. He became the ruler of the Lac-Viet tribe. When De Lai, the king of a northern tribe, visited the south with his daughter Au Co, he admired Lac Long Quan's talent and arranged for Au Co to marry him. Au Co became pregnant and gave birth to a membranous sac containing one hundred eggs, which hatched into one hundred beautiful babies.



These children, descendants of Lac Long Quan and Au Co, are known as the "Dragon and Fairy descendants." The eldest son, King Hung I, established himself in Phong Chau (now part of Phu Tho Province) and became the first of the 18 Hung Kings who ruled Vietnam from 2879 to 258 BC. Their reign marked the impressive beginnings of the Vietnamese nation, characterized by a sense of community, mutual affection, patriotism, and resilience against oppression.
